These funds were created with the purpose of providing leadership and mentorship opportunities for students in every chapter of the WSU Greek Community. The ultimate goal is to lift the entire community; supporting its members as they benefit from the Greek experience of focus on scholarship, friendship, personal excellence, community service and leadership.

With your support we can provide more students with the opportunity to grow as leaders, act as mentors, and improve their community for ALL its members.

Greek Leadership Education Fund:

The entire Greek community benefits when students have the opportunity for leadership training. If even one member of a chapter receives training, they can share their knowledge with other chapter members.

This fund has been established to provide an opportunity for members from each chapter to attend conferences and/or receive mentoring that cultivates and enhances leadership skills. The ultimate goal is to enhance leadership skills of all students in the Greek community.

Greek Community Enrichment Fund:

This fund has been established to provide discretionary resources that benefit the entire Greek community. The fund will allow the Director of the Center for Fraternity and Sorority Life to provide services that enhance the undergraduate learning experience.

Expenditures from this fund can be used to bring educational speakers to campus and provide workshops or materials to educate students about leadership or community engagement. There are other programs that could be provided for students with additional support of this fund. The consistent requirement is that these funds will be used to augment the undergraduate educational experience for students involved in the Greek community.
